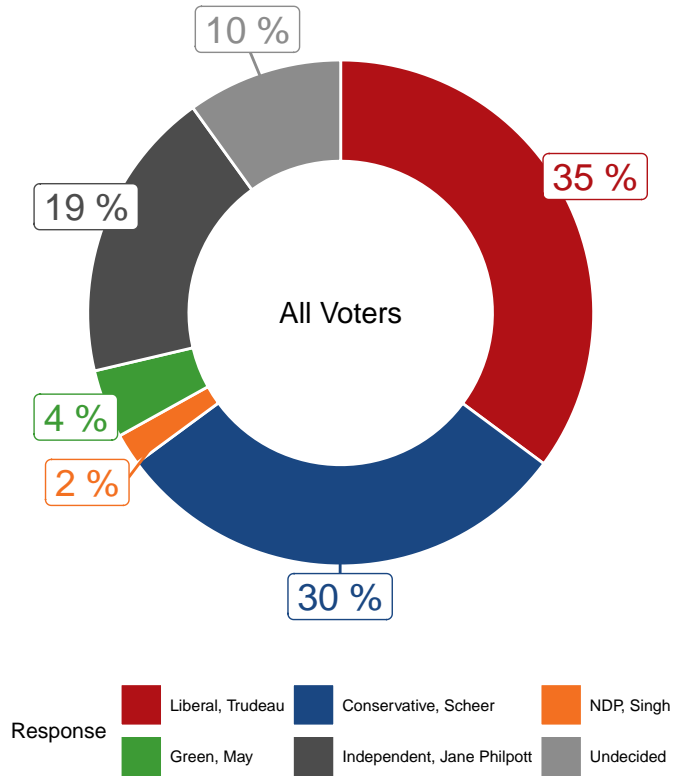
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted on May 29th-30th 2019 among a sample of 601 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in the federal electoral district of Markham-Stouffville. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews (Smart IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Markham-Stouffville.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3.99% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.

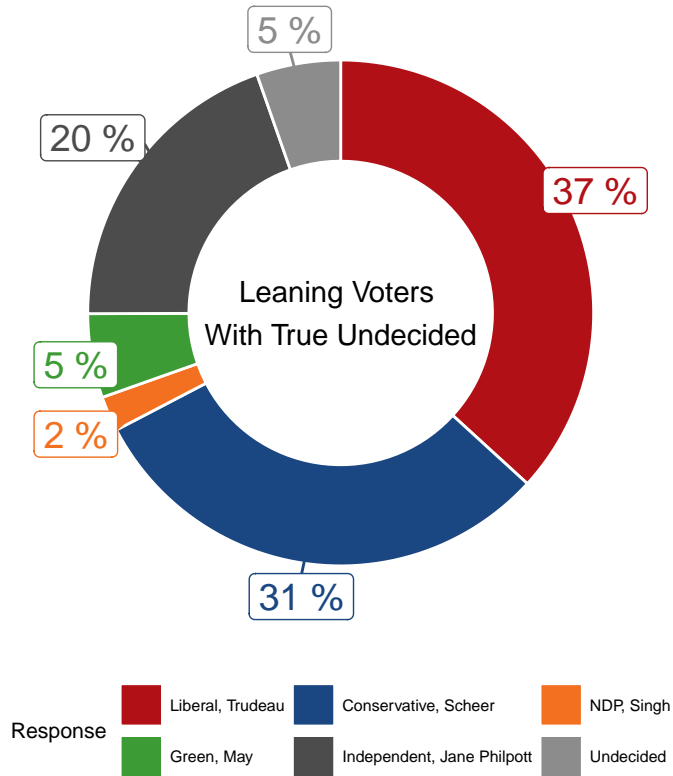

(ALL VOTERS)**



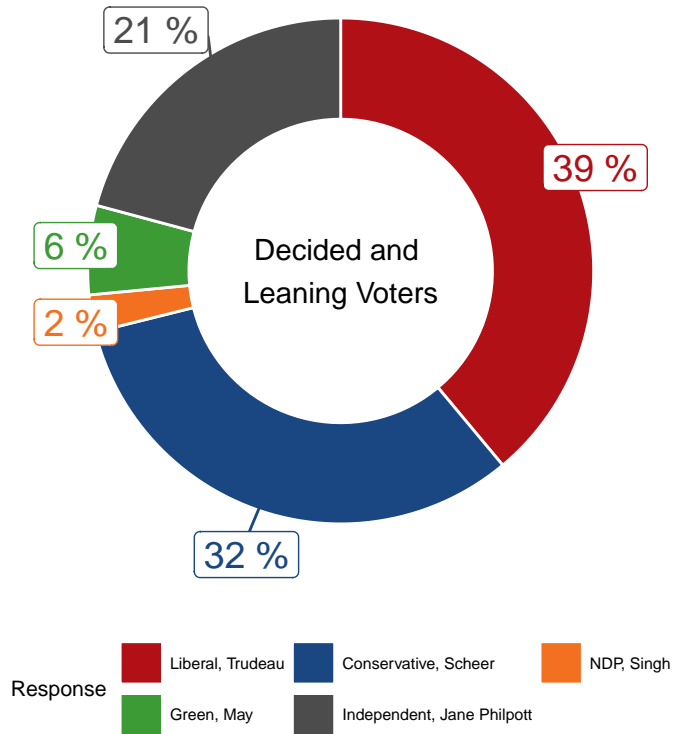

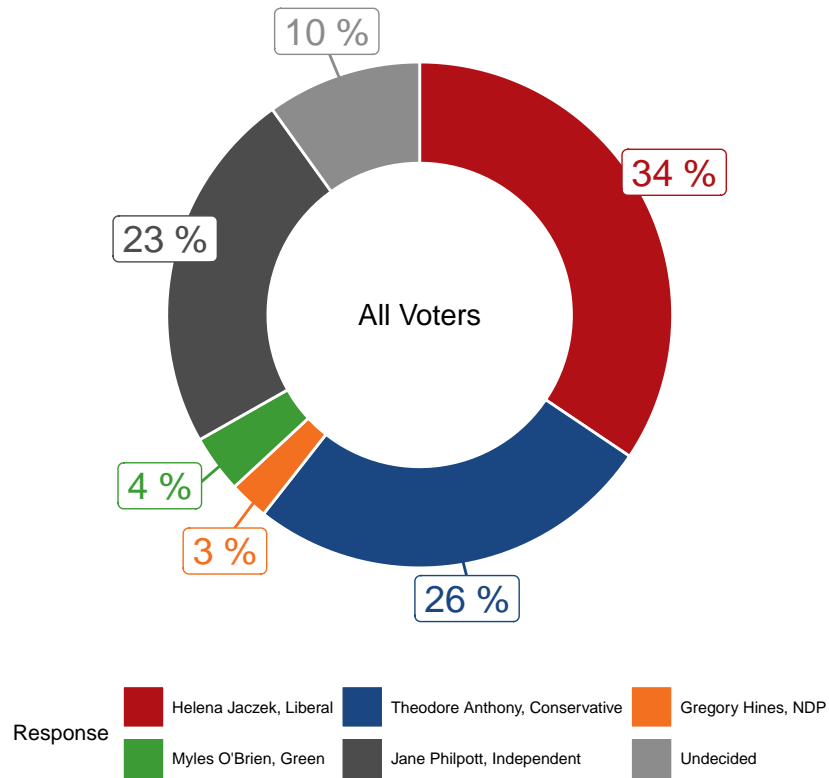

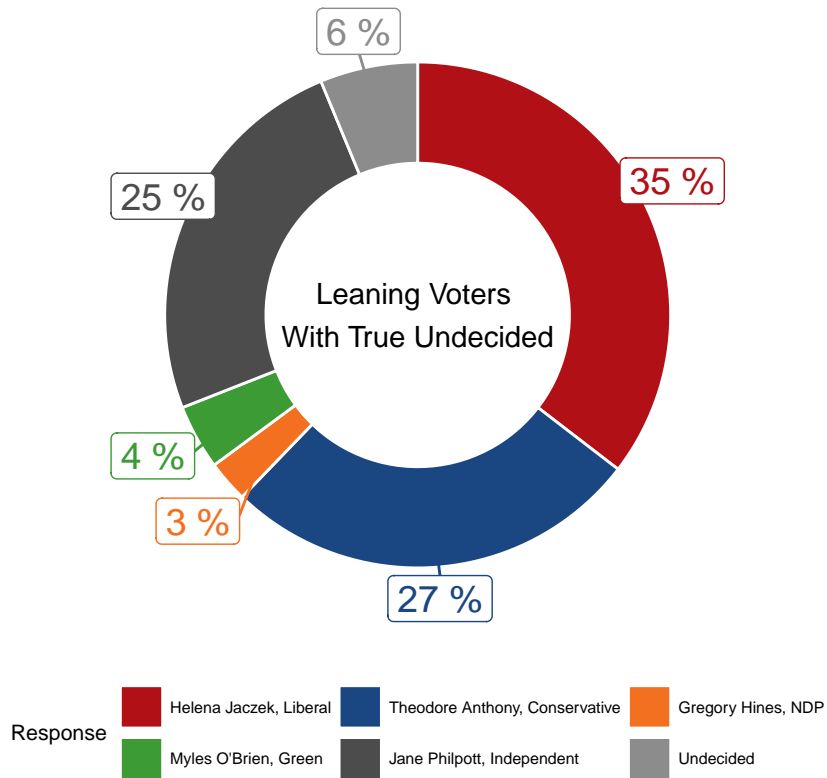

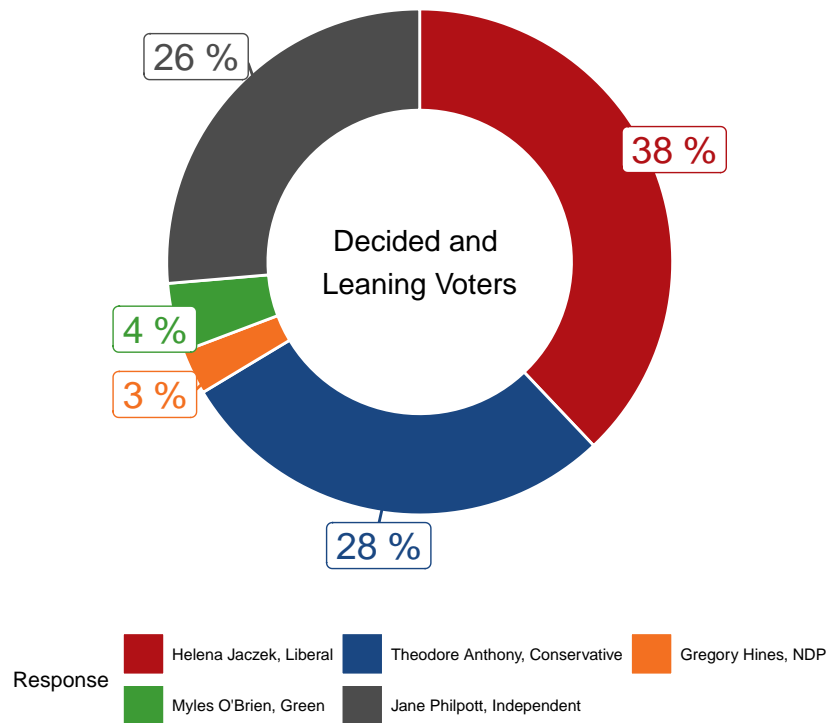
